ER would like to enter into a partnership with select public safety agencies, based on customer loyalty, regional location, and strengthening accountability within the 9-1-1 community. There are several reasons to host classes with Emergency Resources, but the main one is costs savings. The chart below references the incentives for your agency:

ER enters into a contract agreement with the Host Agency, in order to receive the 15% discount. In order for a class to be conducted, ER must have a seven student commitment per class, from the Host Agency.

In addition, ER asks the following from the Host Agency, via a contractional agreement:

- Host 2 E.M.D. classes within a calendar year. (One every 6 months)
- Advertise on G.C.I.C. at least 90 days prior to start of class date.
- Host the class in an accepted classroom facility.
- Agree to collect monies from agencies that are sending students.

Incentives For Your Agency:

Do to the high cost of negative employee retention, this allows you to save, on the repetitive high cost of employee training in order to maintain certification compliance. By being a Host Agency you work the training schedule to satisfy your staffing issues, can charge any tuition to another agency (*adding to or freeing up your training budget*), and receive free tuition incentives from us.¹
